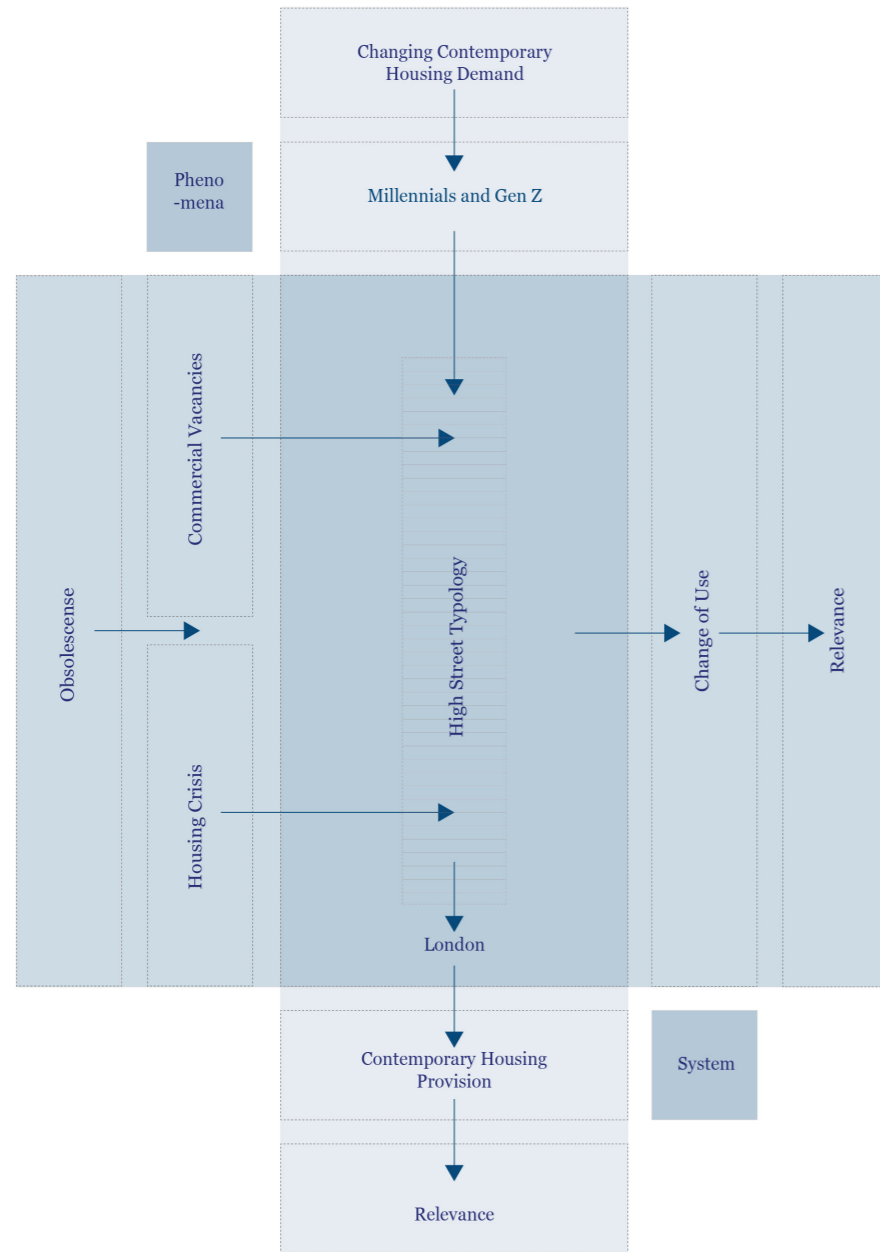

The system allows obsolete typologies to be transformed to relevant typologies for contemporary housing provision.

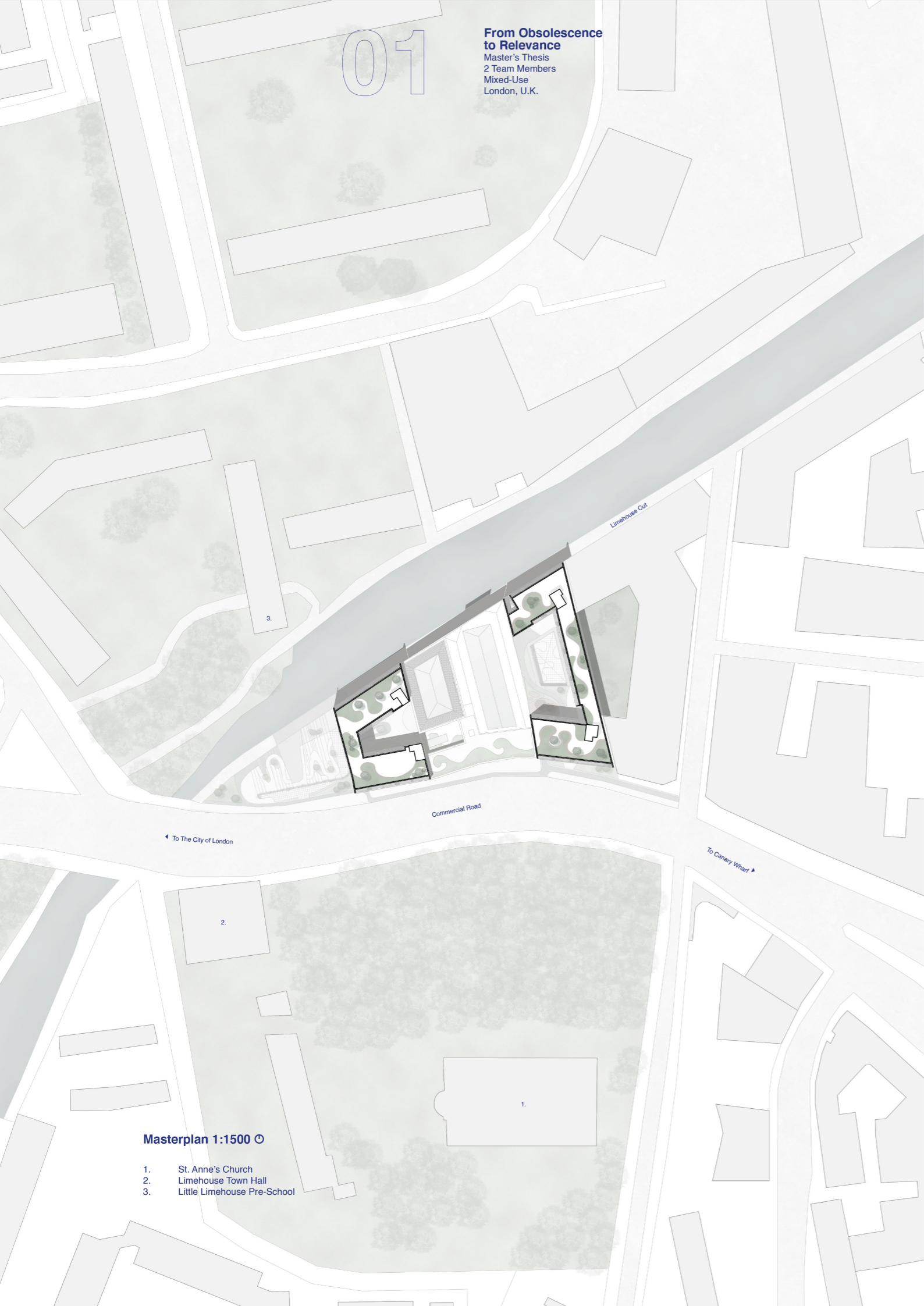

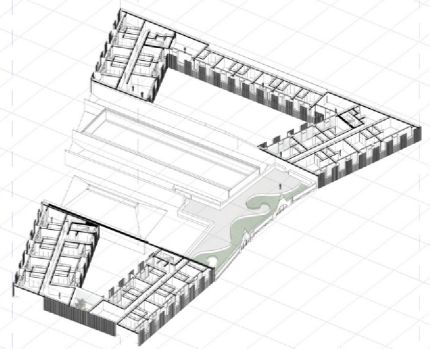
First Floor
Residential area split into two typologies of apartments totalling thirty-five units per floor. Co-working area in the hall of 779-783 Commercial Road.



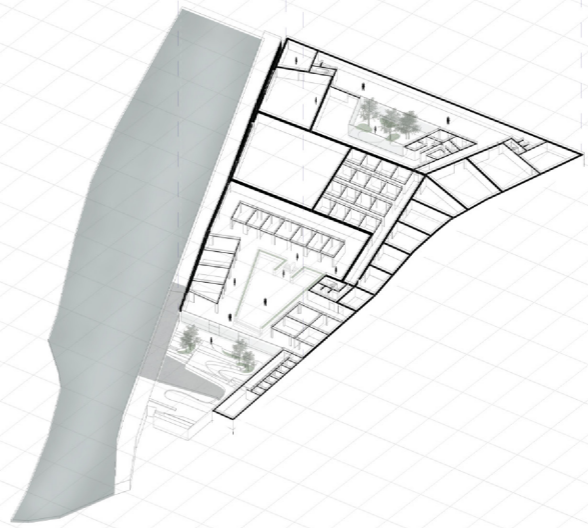
Fourth Floor
Roof gardens above the residential units overlooking Commercial Road and Limehouse Cut.



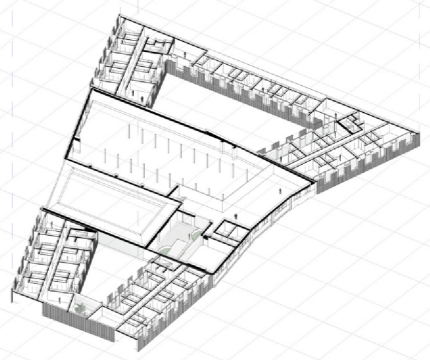
Ground Floor

Residential area split into two typologies of apartments totalling thirty-five units per floor. Roof garden overlooking Commercial Road.



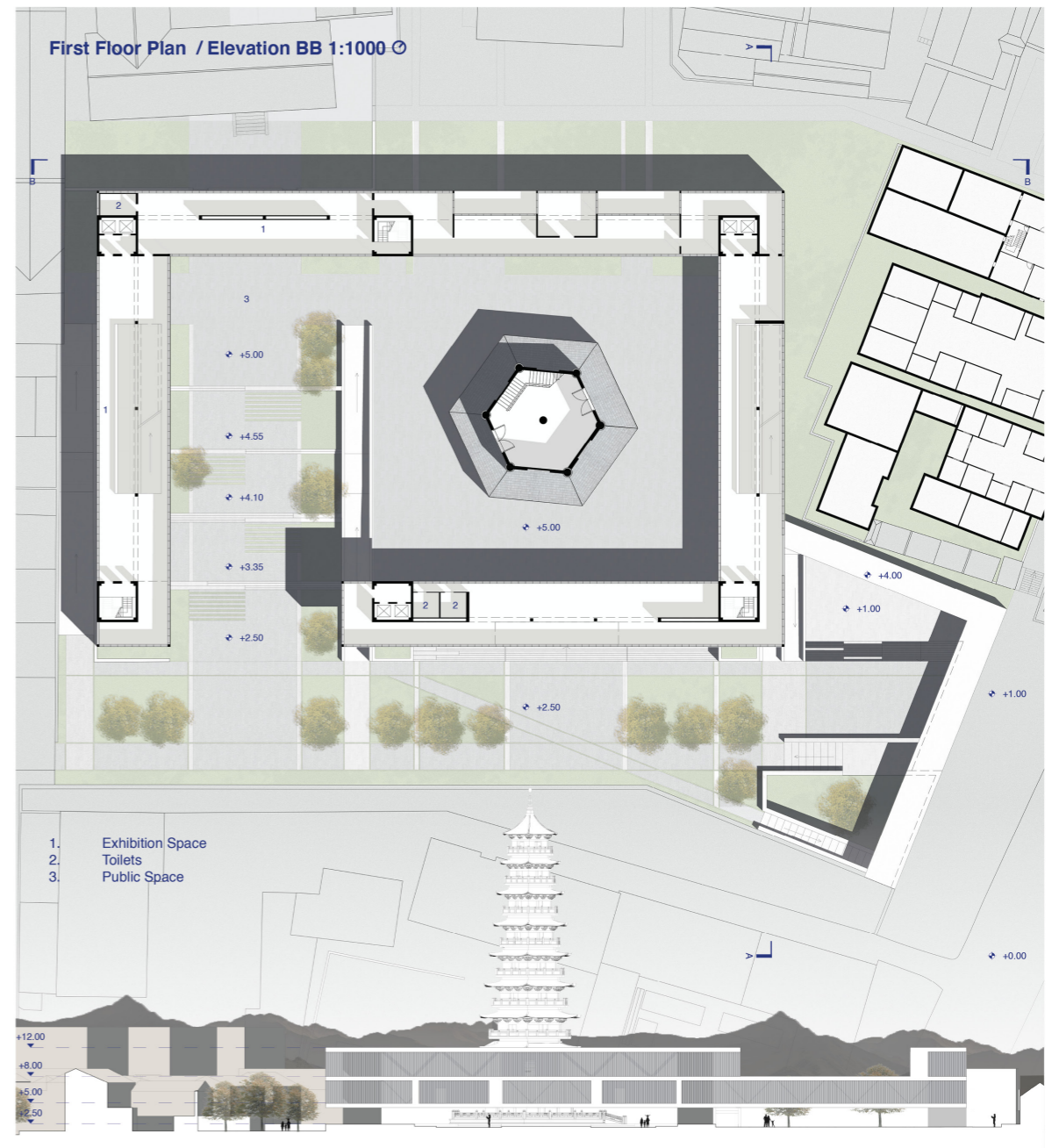
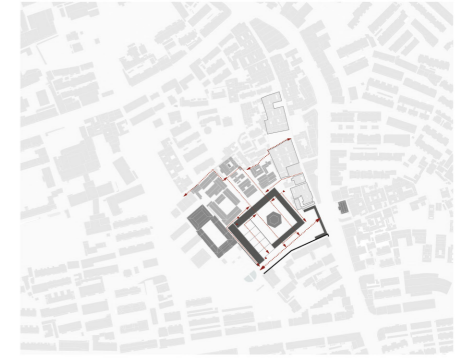
Basement Floor

Residential area split into two typologies of apartments totalling thirty-five units per floor. Meeting rooms overlooking Commercial Road from 777-783.

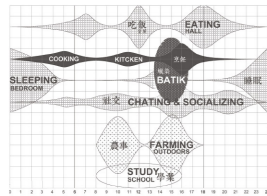

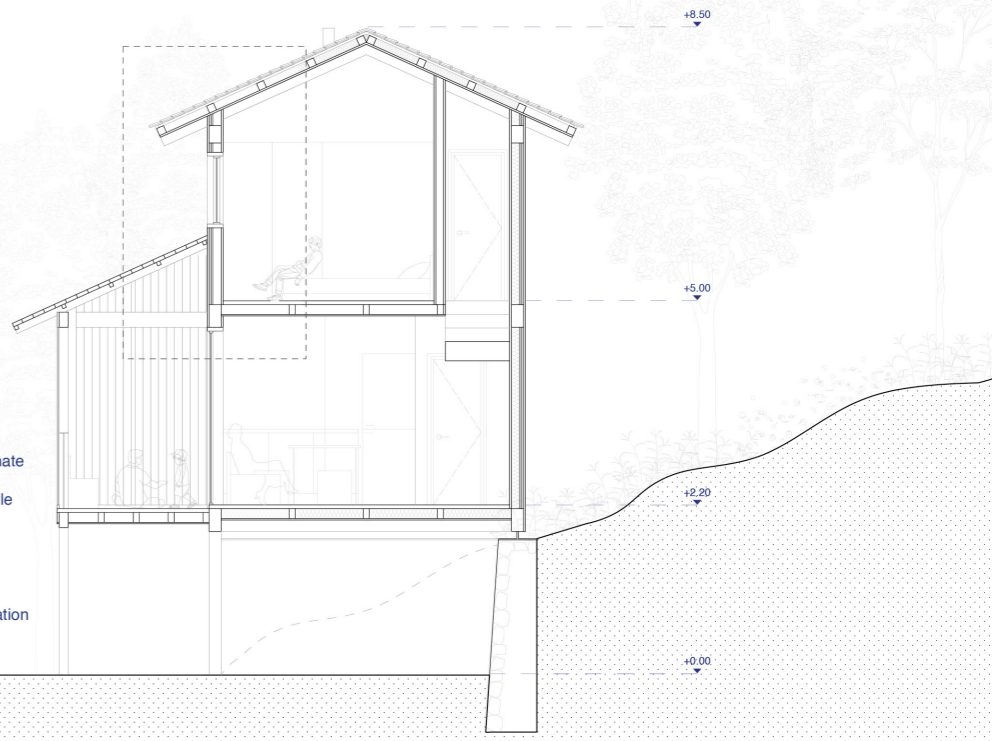


Ground Floor Plan / Section AA 1:100

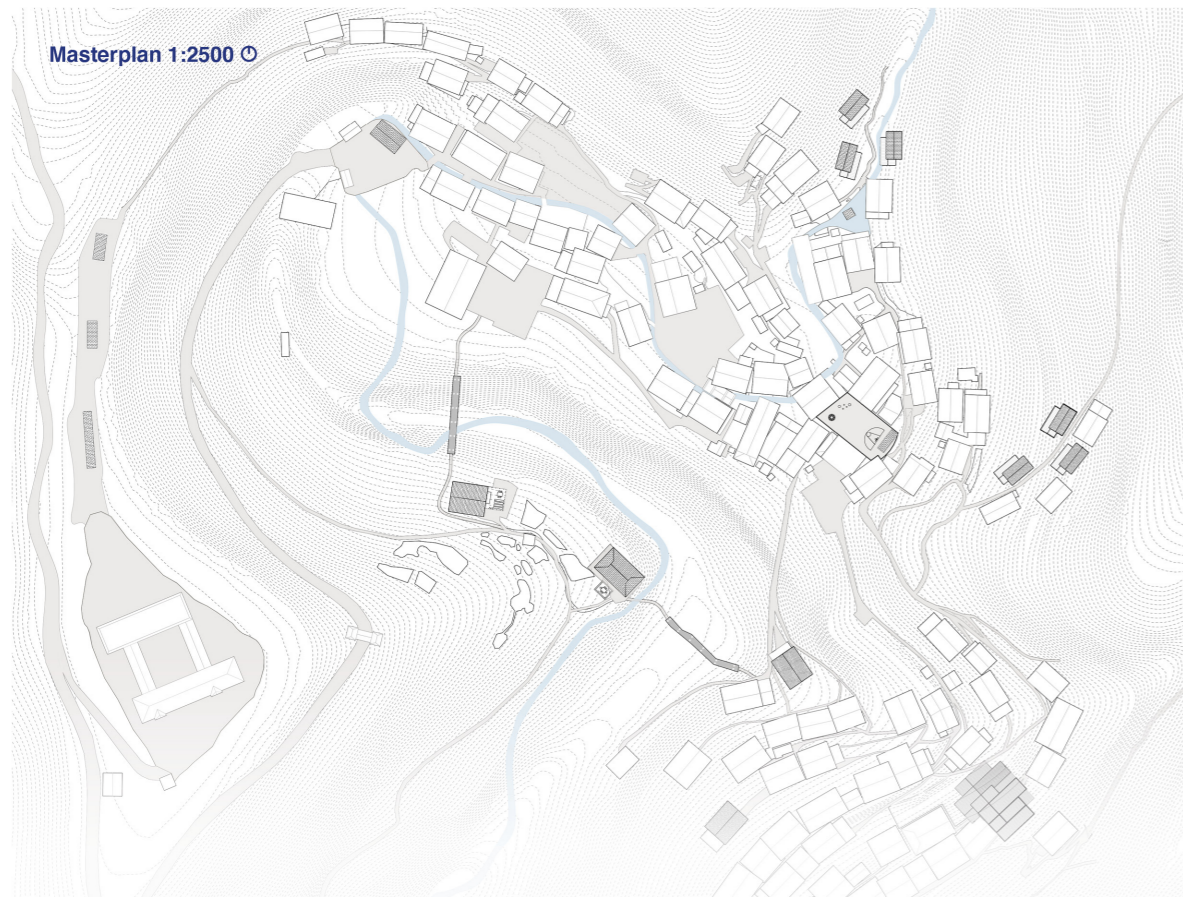

Self-build solution for the Miao ethnic villagers in the remote Denglu village to construct new and adapt pre-existing dwellings with a polycarbonate addition for passive cooling during the day and heat retention in the night.

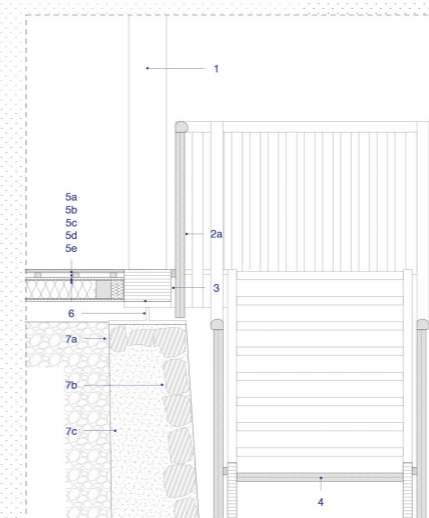


A Batik Centre to celebrate the ancient art of Batik wax-resist dyeing, featuring an artist residency; spaces for the process undertaken in dwellings; for education and exhibitions. The building is situated across pre-existing external pathways with staircases to provide a continuous vertical movement.

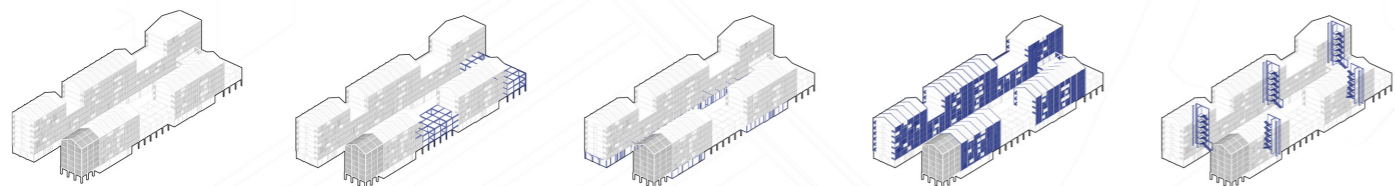
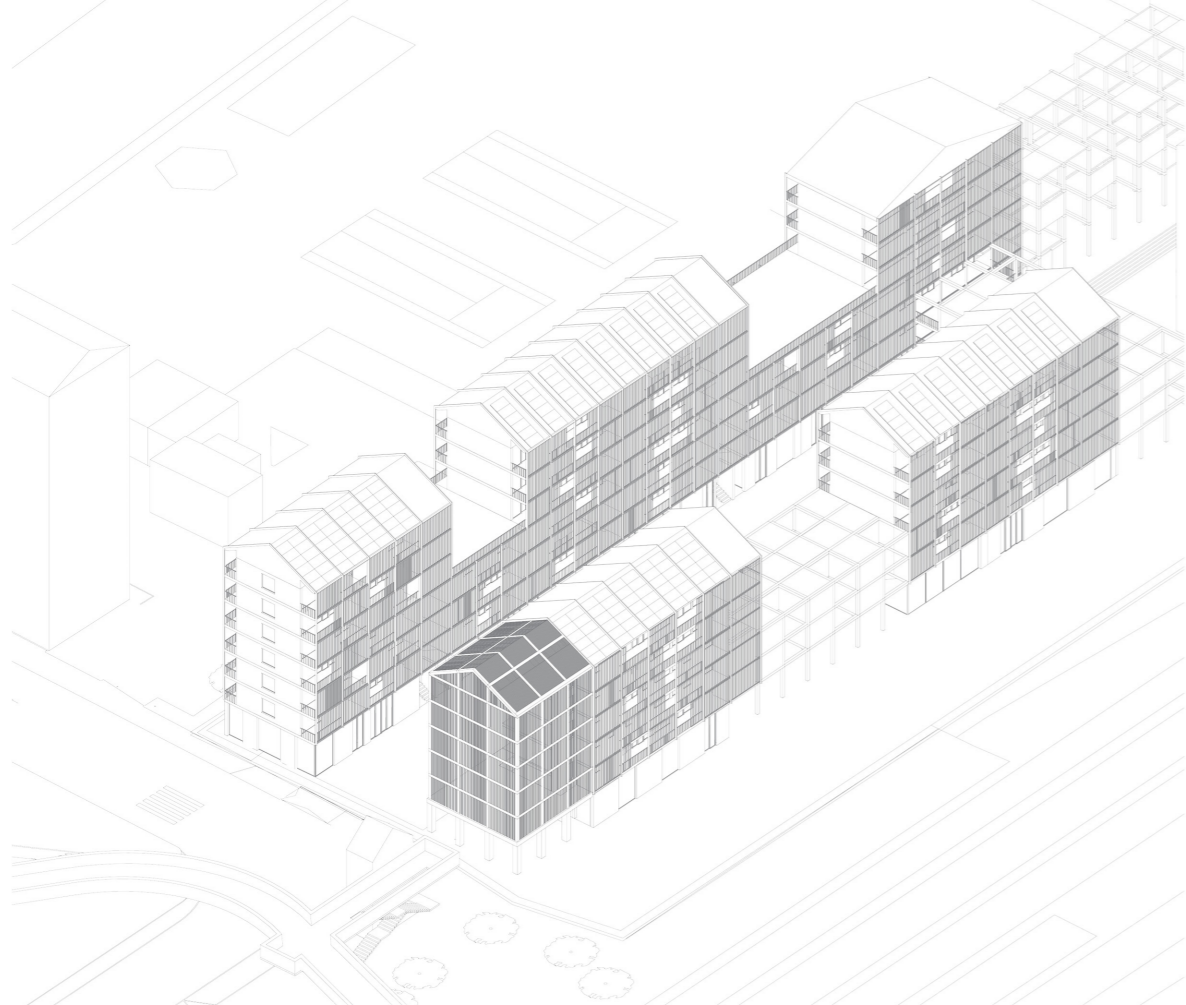

To mediate between the feasibility of a scheme and the necessity to house, with the application of a new value based methodology to bring into contention our association with traditional typologies.

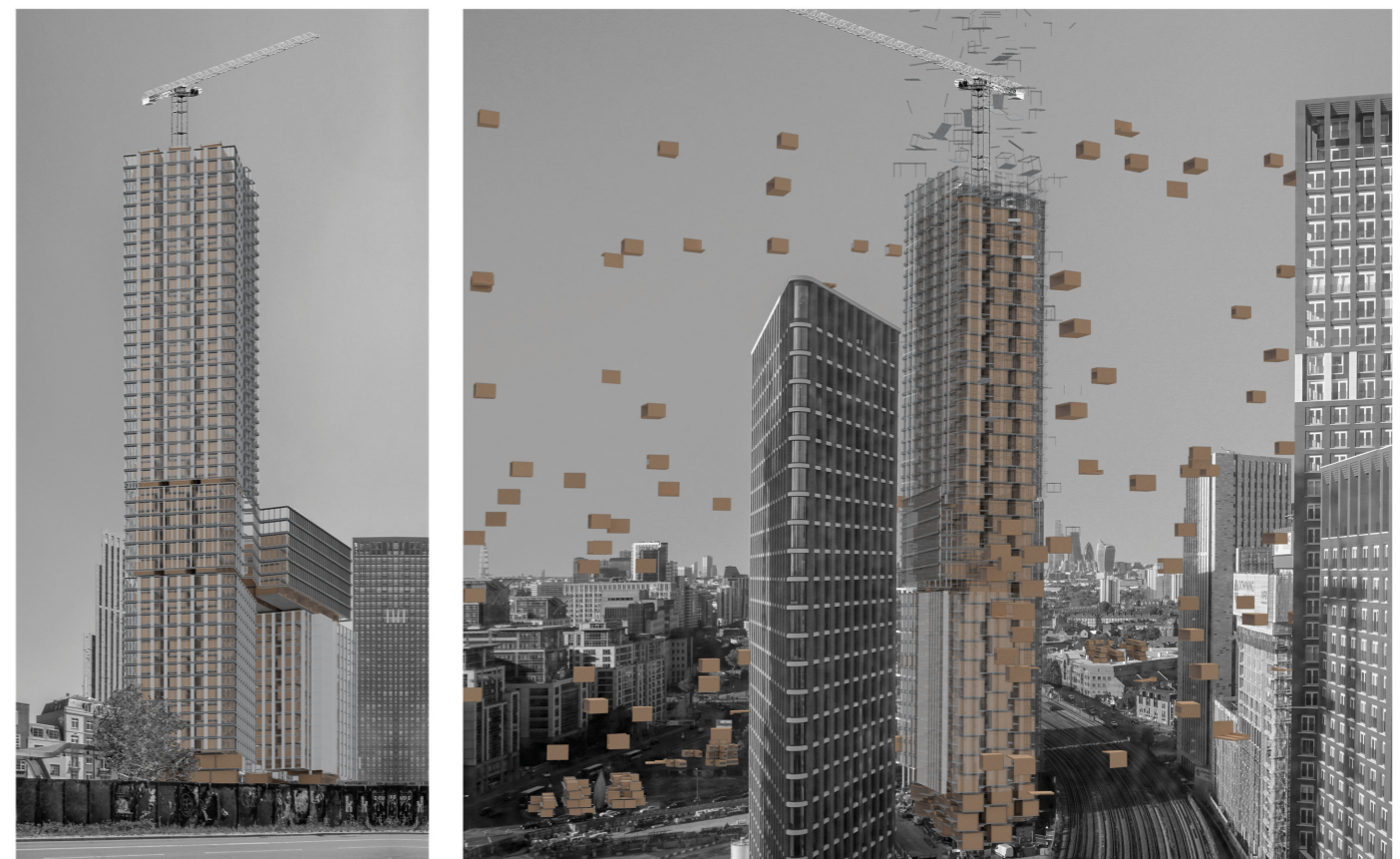
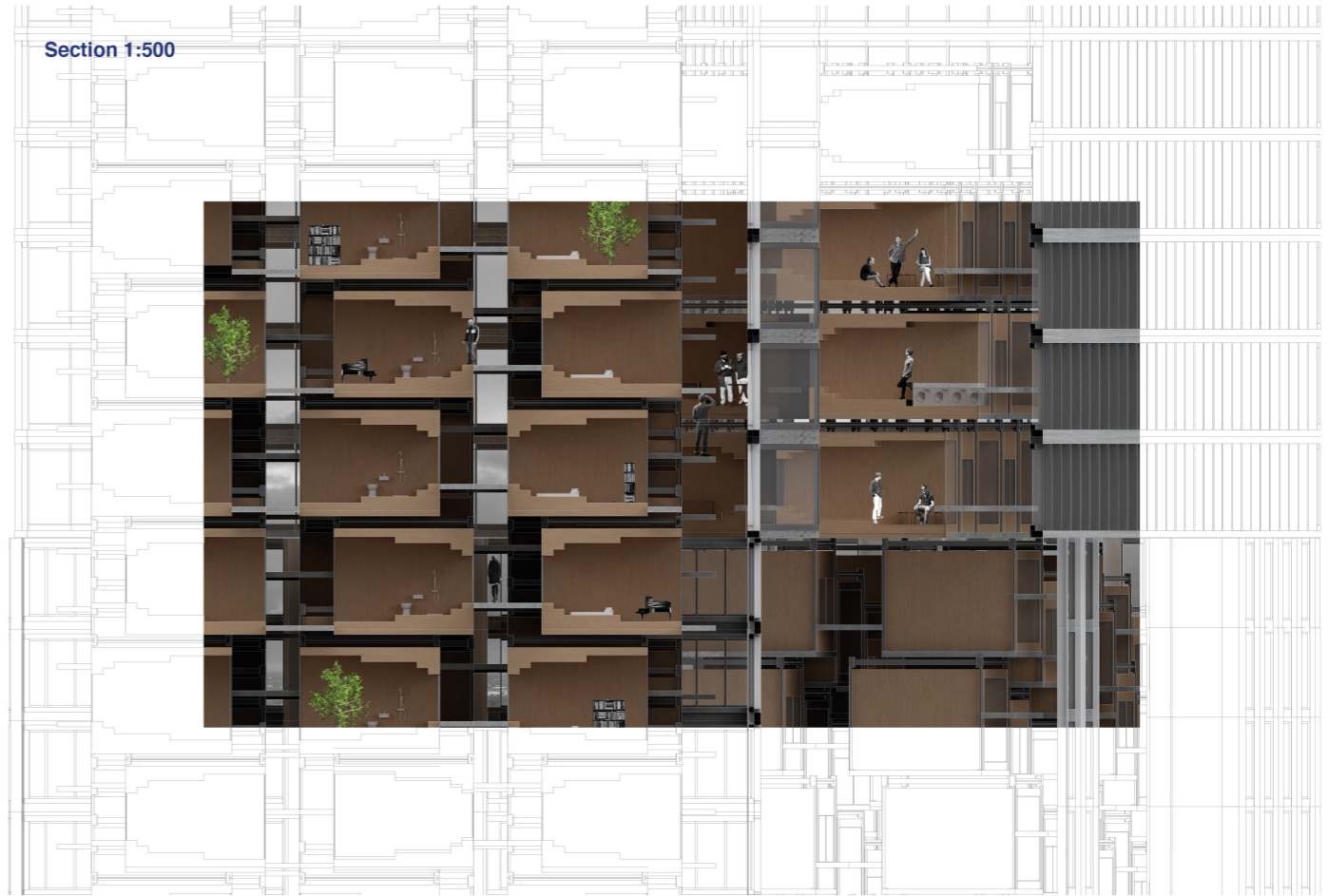
Internal Value System Axonometric 1:1000



External Value System Axonometric 1:10000



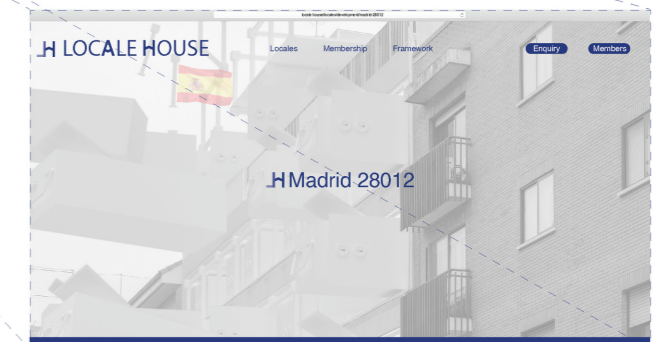
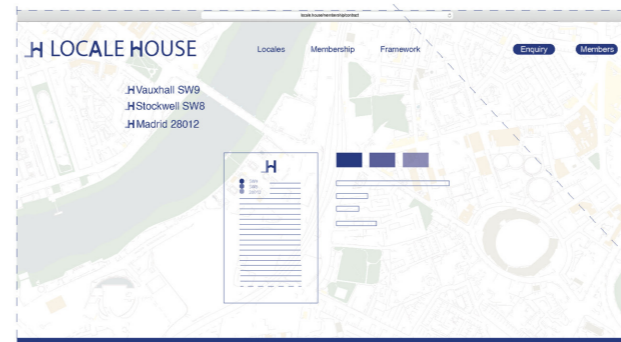
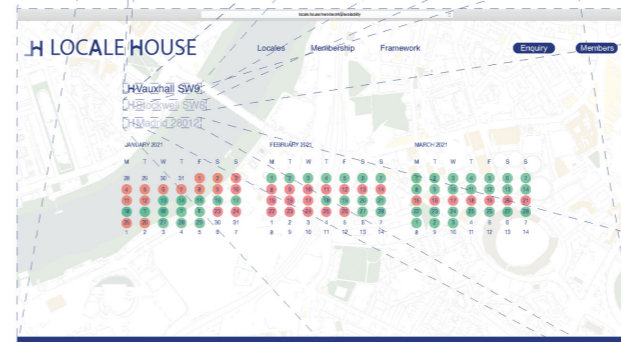
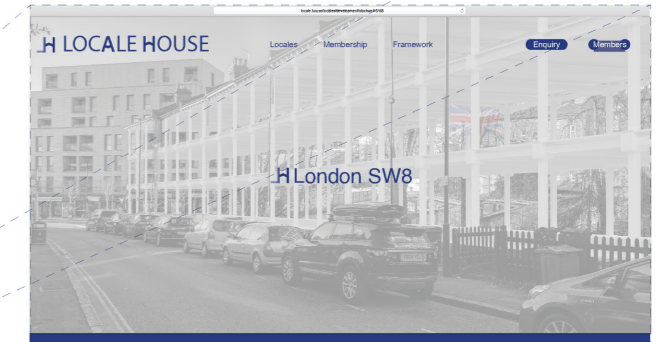
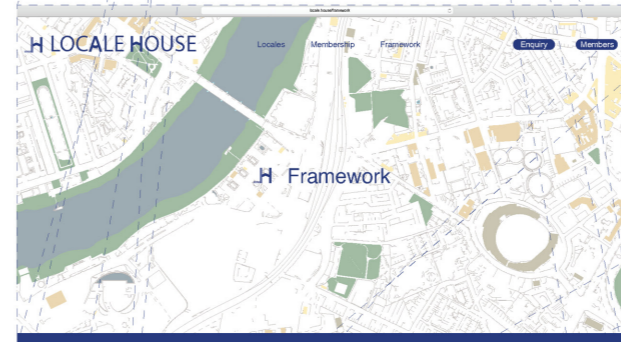
